Please note that payments made by cheque or in cash are at the rates quoted below. Payments by Credit Card or Debit Card may be subject to a surcharge. Surcharges are stipulated on the Harbours Charges section of the Aberdeenshire Council website.

Please note that any item or service not covered by these Rates and Dues will be assessed by the Harbours Service and the Head of Roads and Landscape Services shall have the power to set an appropriate Rate or Fee for that Item or Service.

1 **It must be further noted that any legitimate cost incurred by the Harbours Service on behalf of any vessel, skipper, owner, or agent whether requested or not by that person/vessel shall be recharged to that person/vessel including any administrative or service costs so associated.**

2 **VESSELS**

- Note:
- (i) VAT shall be charged at the current rate on vessels under 15 gross registered tons
 - (ii) All reference to length in this section shall mean registered length

2.1 **Composition Fee for Fishing Vessels**

2.1.1 For any fishing vessel normally and regularly landing fish, a composition fee in lieu of rates for such vessels for each quarter year payable in arrears if normally berthed in the Harbour, or upon departure from the Harbour, or as otherwise specifically arranged and approved by the Head of Service, will be:-

Vessels under 10m	£33.99
10-17m	£51.01
17-22 m	£75.75
22-26 m	£92.77
26-30 m	£108.22
over 30 m	£176.23

2.1.2 The above rates shall not apply to the following harbours except by special arrangement with the Harbours Service:- Rates and Dues

Banff, Gourdon, Johnshaven, Portsoy, Roseheartly, and Stonehaven.

2.1.3 If, after paying the composition fee, the vessel ceases to regularly land fish, each entry to the harbour shall be charged in accordance with Section 2.2.

For the purpose of this section regularly landing fish means a minimum fish dues paid per quarter equal to the vessel harbour dues.

2.2 Single Entry all Vessels

2.2.1 For any vessel for which no composition fee has been paid, the rate payable on each entry, valid for 1 week or part thereof or as otherwise specifically arranged, shall be:-

2.2.2 When fish are landed on any one entry where the value of such landing is greater than the value of the berthing rate the rate shall be reduced by one half.

2.2.3 Emergency Repair on any one entry the rate shall be reduced by one half

- 3.1.1 For all recreational vessels a composition fee payable biannually in advance in lieu of rates shall be:-

Minimum charge (INC VAT) (up to 6 metres) £116.88

Additional charge for each metre or part of a metre in excess of 6 metres (INC VAT) £20.41

For Banff (traditional berthing and compound only berthing), Macduff and Stonehaven only

- 3.1.2 For all recreational vessels a composition fee payable biannually in advance in

- 3.1.3 The composition fee payable annually for a twelve-month berthing in advance in lieu of rates shall be: -

Minimum charge (INC VAT) (up to 6 metres) £841.39

Additional charge for each metre or part of a metre in excess of 6 metres (INC VAT) £133.22

- 3.1.4 The composition fee payable in advance for a six-month berthing in lieu of fees shall be 75% of that payable for an annual berth: -

Minimum charge (INC VAT) (up to 6 metres) £631.05

3.1.5 Payment at Banff Harbour Marina for Annual Fees may be made in staged payments, with the approval of the Harbourmaster and Harbours Service, as follows:

Six month Berthing, Summer, may be paid in one instalment equal to 75% of the annual fee before 1 April in any year or by payment of 50% of the annual fee before 1 April and 25% of the annual Fee before 1 July in any year.

Twelve month Berthing may be paid in one instalment equal to the annual fee before 1 April in any year or by payment of 50% of the annual fee before 1 April, 25% of the annual Fee before 1 July, and 25% of the annual fee before 1 October in any year.

All other Berthing Fees shall be paid in full before 1 April in any year for summer or twelve month berthing and before 1 October where winter berthing in Harbour or Compound is required.

Dependent upon availability, the Harbourmaster may sub-let any pontoon berth to a visitor for part or all of the winter season only. This shall be made available upon payment of 50% of the annual fee for that berth. The visitor shall be bound by the normal rules and regulations governing the harbour.

3.2 Single Entry (and Rover Ticket)

3.2.1 Where no composition fee under Section 3.1 or 3.2 has been paid, dues shall be payable on entry into the harbour and shall be charged as follows:-

3.3 General

- 3.3.1 Masters of vessels paying harbour dues under any of the above categories who engage in commercial fishing shall be required to declare the value of the catch to the Harbourmaster within 7 days of landing and to pay the appropriate fish landing dues either directly to the Council or to a fish salesman or purchaser, duly authorised by Aberdeenshire Council to collect such dues.
- 3.3.2 Registered fishing vessels not regularly landing fish and that are not charged under Section 2 shall be charged as recreational vessels.
- 3.3.3 Vessels which are stored on ground owned or administered by Aberdeenshire Council shall be charged in terms of Sections 3.1, 3.2 or 3.3.
- 3.3.4 Composition fees under 3.1 shall apply to the periods from 1st April to 30th September and from 1st October to 31st March. A single payment for consecutive periods shall only apply where winter mooring or berthage is available.

4. **WHARFAGE**

- Note:
- (i) The following rates shall normally apply to goods shipped, transhipped or unshipped within a harbour area.
 - (ii) Under this section fish landed and consigned for sale at another Aberdeenshire Council Harbour shall be charged only at the port of landing.

10.	GENERAL CONDITIONS	
10.1	Cargo dues shall be payable prior to the shipment or discharge of any goods, unless the shipper or consignee has been granted credit terms by the Council. The Council reserve the right to retain any goods in respect of which the cargo dues have not been paid, and that at the cost of the shipper or the consignee, as the case may be, until the dues and costs thereby incurred by the Council are settled in full.	
10.2	Cargo dues shall be charged on goods according to gross metric tonnage or other chargeable unit, as specified in the schedule, subject to a minimum charge of £1.00. Fractional parts of any chargeable unit shall be rounded off to the nearest half unit.	
10.3	Dues shall be payable on goods once only, where - <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (1) the goods are landed from any vessel and re-shipped in the same or in another vessel (in the same packaging) and there is no change in the consignee, and that within the period of one month, or, (2) the goods require to be repackaged because of any damage to, or the destruction of, the original packaging. 	
10.4	Dues shall be payable on goods, containers, and any other equipment or property stored at harbour premises.

10.5 Any person engaged in the fish trade who is authorised, as agent of the Council, to deduct from the selling price of fish landed or consigned at a harbour, an amount in respect of the harbour dues thereon, shall record details of each transaction, including the quantities of fish bought and sold, the amount payable and the deduction in respect of harbour dues. Such records shall be open to inspection by the Council, when required.

10.6 (1) Payment of a composition fee in terms of Sections 3.1 and 3.2 shall relate only to the vessel and the harbour area in respect of which it has been paid.

(2) By special arrangement and subject to the availability of berthage, a vessel, for which a composition fee has been paid, may be berthed in another harbour area administered by the Council without further charge for the maximum period of one week. This provision shall not apply at Macduff harbour.

10.7 Charge for Fishing Gear for Unauthorised Storage on Pier

Charge per item per day, after 1 weeks, for gear left on pier excluding vessels under repair. All gear stored on the piers is to be tagged with name and number of vessel. (INCL VAT).
